Tasks

Placement the parade and church





Banner bearer

- Responsibility for the legate- /consulate- /senate- banner by the banner bearer
- Leading the procession when entering and leaving
- Banner always carried standing
- In the procession the flag points backwards
- When entering and leaving the church, the flag points to the front
- Lineup in the church according to the officiating marshal
- Bowing of the banner at:
 - Gospel, Consecration, “Father Our”, Prayer of Eques, Obituary

Adjustment: Ornate/ Sash Determination by acting marschal



Banner bearer escort

- Only option for female wine knights
- Two banner ascorts desired (left and right of the first banner)

Adjustment: Festive clothing and sashes





Stave bearer

- Responsibility for the legate-/ consulate-/ senat- stave by the stave bearer
- Placement in the procession according to the banners when entering and leaving
- Lineup in the church according to the officiating marshal
- Before the religious mass, strike the staff once in the middle of the altar ®
- Before the knightly ceremony, strike the staff three times

® ®® and say:

“High ceremonial assembly, the General- Consul (/ the Consul/ the Consules) and the incumbent Senate”

Adjustment: Ornat and **white gloves**





Chalice bearer

- Responsibility for the legate-/ consulate-/ senate- chalice by the chalice bearer
- Placement in the procession according to banner and stave when entering and leaving
- Lineup in the church according to the officiating marshal
- The chalice is only filled shortly before the knightly ceremony
- Handing over the chalice to the priest (consul) during accreditation and enthronement



Adjustment: Ornat, **white gloves** and **cloth**



Sword bearer



- Responsibility for the legate-/ consulate-/ senate-sword by the sword bearer
- Basic sword position over the left shoulder (Knight of Peace)
- The sword bearer is already in the equipment room to the right of the consul.
- Placement in the procession always directly in front of the Consul
- During the ceremony, the sword always stands to the consul's right



Adjustment: Ornat and **white gloves**



Sword bearer

- Sword presentation with both hands centered in front of the chest with the tip pointing upwards
- Sword presentation at the order mass:
 - Gospel, Consecration, “Father Our”, Prayer of eques, Obituary
- Presentation of the sword in the act of knight ceremony during the consul's speech
- During accreditations and enthronements, the sword is handed over to the acting consul (**sword lying on end with the tip away from the altar**)
- Placement when leaving the church and in the procession before the consul

Adjustment: Ornat and **white gloves**



Hygiene rules of conduct

- Masks where required!
- Procession: Pay attention to the legally required distance!
- Lineup the Senate in the chancel at appropriate distances
- Line up the candidates next to each other
 - If there is not enough space, place it in the nave
 - Candidates advance one by one and then go back to the outside and line up again at the back.



Hygiene rules of conduct

- Candidates place their hand over the sword (without touching)
- During enthronement, the sword strikes the candidate's shoulder
- Insignia is presented at a distance
- After the insignia, the marshal presents each candidate with a glass and they come forward to the priest
 - The priest raises the chalice and says “in honorem dei et” and the candidates respond “in honorem vini”. Only drink afterwards.
 - The consul raises the chalice and says “in honorem dei et” and the candidates respond “in honorem vini”. Then drink empty.
- The marshal collects the glasses

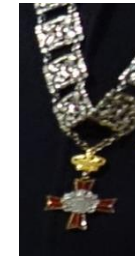

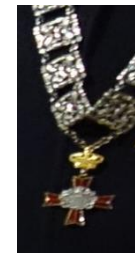
