Assistant functions

Banner bearer

- Responsibility for the Legation/Consulate/Senate banner rests with the banner bearer
- Leading the procession during entry and exit
- Banner always carried standing
- In the procession, the flag points backward
- When entering and exiting the church, the flag points forward
- Arrangement in the church according to the serving marshal
- Bowing of the banner at:
 - Gospel, Transformation, "Our Father, Eques prayer, Necrology

Adjustment: Vestments/sash determination by the serving marshal



Banner escort

- Only opportunity for female wine knights
- Two banner escorts desired (left and right of the first banner)

Adjustment: Festive clothing and sashes





Staff bearer

- Responsibility for the Legation/Consulate/Senate staff rests with the staff bearer
- Placement in the procession according to the banners during entry and exit
- Arrangement in the church according to the serving marshal
- Before the order mass, a single strike of the staff centered in front of the altar
- Before the knighthood act, three times striking of the staff and reciting:
"High ceremonial assembly, the general consul (the consul/the consuls) and the serving Senate"



Adjustment: Vestments and white gloves



Chalice bearer

- Responsibility for the Legation/Consulate/Senate chalice rests with the chalice bearer
- Placement in the procession after the banner and staff during entry and exit
- Arrangement in the church according to the serving marshal
- The chalice is filled only shortly before the knight ceremony
- Chalice transfer at the accreditation and enthronement to the priest (Consul)

Adjustment: Vestments, white gloves and cloth





Sword bearer

- Responsibility for the Legation/Consulate/Senate sword rests with the sword bearer
- Basic sword position over the left shoulder (Knights of Peace)
- The sword bearer is already in the armory to the right of the Consul
- Placement in the procession always directly in front of the Consul
- During the ceremony, the sword is always to the right of the Consul

Adjustment: Vestments and white gloves





Sword bearer

- Sword presentation with both hands centered in front of the chest with the tip pointing up
- Sword presentation in the service at:
 - Gospel, Transformation, \"Our Father, Eques prayer
- Sword presentation in the knighthood ceremony during the Consul's speech
- During accreditations and enthronements, the sword is handed over to the acting Consul (sword lying with the point away from the altar)
- During the procession, positioning in front of the Consul

Adjustment: Robe and white gloves



Hygiene Behavior Rules

- Masks as far as required!
- Procession: Observe the legally required distance!
- Formation of the Senate in the altar area with each respective distance
- Formation of the candidates side by side
 - If there is not enough space, formation in the church nave
 - Candidates move forward individually and then return from the outside and line up at the back again



Hygiene Behavior Rules

- Candidates place their hand over the sword (without touching)
- During enthronements, the knighthood blow occurs on the shoulder
- Insignia is handed over at a distance
- After the insignia, the Marshal hands each candidate a glass and they then come forward to the Priest
 - The Priest raises the chalice and says 'in honor of God' and the candidates respond with 'in honor of wine.' Only then drink.
 - The Consul raises the chalice and says 'in honor of God' and the candidates respond with 'in honor of wine.' Then drink empty
- Collection of glasses by the Marshal

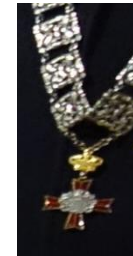

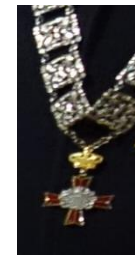
